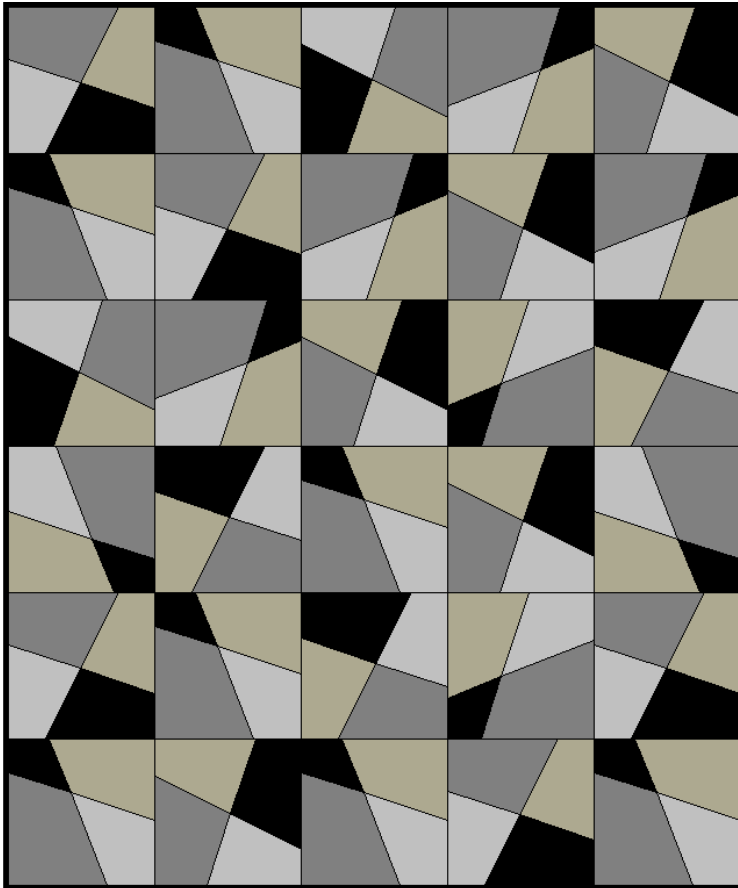


“Just for You”

(40" x 48" quilt) (8" finished Stack-n-Slash blocks)



Fabric Requirements: 30 – 10" squares

Use the Stack-n-Slash method to make 30 squares.
Square up each square to 8½" x 8½". (8" finished blocks)
Arrange in a 5 x 6 layout.

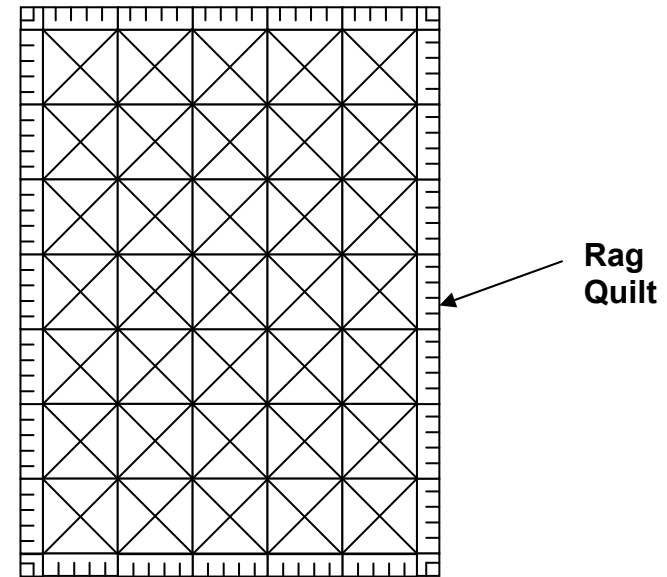
Backing and Binding: 3 yards

**** Make it Special!!**

You can play with different layout arrangements!!

“Just for You”

(45" x 62½" quilt) (5 x 7 layout)



Fabric Requirements:

35 sets – 10" squares of flannel/homespun ******(70 total)
35 – 9½" squares of batting

Use a walking foot for all sewing of this type of quilt!!

Sandwich a batting square in between 2 - 10" flannel/homespun squares and stitch an "X" across all 3 layers.

Layout the 35 'sandwich' blocks in a 5 x 7 grid.

Using a 5/8" seam, sew the quilt together. Don't forget to sew around the entire outside edge of the quilt, too!!

Using good spring-action scissors, clip into all the loose seam allowances ¼" deep.

Wash and dry so that the clipped edges will fluff up!!!

No backing or binding required!
