

Optional Bonus for MA 120 Test #2 Fall 2009

- A. Complete homework on CourseCompass for bonus points added to Test #2 as follows: (available until day of Test #2)
 - 1. 70% – 79% correct = 1 point
 - 2. 80% - 89% correct = 2 points
 - 3. 90% - 100% correct = 3 points

- B. Complete one origami from my “page a day calendar” and show finished product to class = 1 point (ask me for the origami page—due one class day prior to test #2)

- C. Demonstrate a problem on the chalkboard or overhead projector from study guide #2 for the class. This will be a problem that has not yet been worked in class. You must ask the instructor for approval of your question or have one assigned. Study Guide #2 will be handed out in class. Demonstration, accuracy, and clarity must be shown for a possible 2 bonus points. One problem per student. If you choose to work in pairs, then each student receives one bonus point. (due one class day prior to test #2)

- D. Demonstrate a new, relevant topic on the graphing calculator for the class. You must ask the instructor for approval of your topic or have one assigned. Using the overhead grapher, you will demonstrate a new feature of the calculator for the class by showing a relevant example/problem from the textbook. This is due the class day prior to test #2. Demonstration, relevancy, and clarity must be shown for a possible 2 bonus points. One problem per student. If you choose to work in pairs, then each student receives one bonus point.
