

Optional Bonus for MA 120 Test #3 Fall 2009

- A. Complete homework on CourseCompass for bonus points added to Test #3 as follows: (available until day of Test #3)

Notice these points have been increased—a one time occurrence.

1. 70% – 79% correct = 1 point
2. 80% - 89% correct = 3 points
3. 90% - 100% correct = 5 points

- B. Complete one origami from my “page a day calendar” and show finished product to class = 1 point (ask me for the origami page—due one class day prior to test #3)

- C. Demonstrate a problem from study guide #3 using only your graphing calculator for the class. Please ask the instructor for approval of your question or to have one assigned. Study Guide #3 is posted on the instructor’s webpage. Demonstration, accuracy, and clarity must be shown for a possible 2 bonus points. One problem per student. If you choose to work in pairs, then each student receives one bonus point. (due one class day prior to test #3)

- D. Type a double spaced 3 – 5 page paper on the relevancy of one or more of the topics discussed thus far in this course to your declared major. Discuss how you might use topics or ideas presented in this course for your future line of work or study. Be specific to your case. Use MLA or APA style with at least three sources--(no Wikipedia, please). Title page and reference page do not count as part of the 3 – 5 pages. Total possible bonus = up to 5 points (due one class day prior to test #3). Paper will be graded on proper format, relevant content, originality, apparent depth of student insight and understanding, etc.

- E. Find two websites that could be used for studying any topic of your choice presented in this course. These could include instructional or interactive sites, podcasts, vodcasts, etc. Please e-mail me the links with an explanation for each of your choices and their relevancy to the course. Have these links available for students in class one day prior to test #3. Points = 2
